On March 30, 2007, after 4 meetings, the Education Subcommittee completed its work and presented a report to the General Conference Committee. We are pleased to present this report which provides detail on all the budget changes agreed to by the Subcommittee.

## 1. General Support for Public School (GSPS) Programs

Agreement has been reached on the following:

- An estimated \$1.7 billion increase for education aid over last year;
- · Creation of a Foundation Aid Formula which increases aid by approximately \$1.1 billion over last year;
- The use of a State Sharing Ratio as well as a Mills Choice in order to calculate the State and local share
  of Foundation Aid in order to decrease the number of districts on Save Harmless;
- A four year increase in Foundation Aid of approximately \$5 billion;
- An increase in Universal Prekindergarten above the Executive;
- Supplemental Excess Cost Aid to recognize certain special education costs; and
- Other unrestricted aids which recognize school district needs and tax burden.

## 2. Grant Programs and Other Aid Categories

• The Legislature is still looking at other important programmatic adds including Libraries, Independent Living Centers, Teacher Centers, the Teacher Mentor Intern Program and Mandated Services Aid.

## 3. Article VII Proposals

The members of the Joint Conference Subcommittee on Education agree to accept the following Executive proposals:

- Allowing the Chancellor of the Board of Regents to delegate the Chairmanship of the Cultural Education Trust to his/her designee from the Board of Regents;
- > Chapter one advances and pension accrual extension;
- > Continuing language related to the use of Teachers of Tomorrow funds by New York City; and
- > Rochester BOCES extension to comply with health services requirement.
- The Legislature is still looking at language on accountability measures, class size and charter schools
